DSCI Concludes Acquisition of Viatech, Inc.

(Eatontown, N.J.) July 1, 2007 – D&S Consultants, Inc. (DSCI) today announced that it completed the acquisition of Viatech, Inc., a full-spectrum systems engineering, information management, and technical services organization with government and industry customers. DSCI plans to integrate Viatech, Inc. (Viatech, Inc. – A DSCI Company) seamlessly within its Government Systems Group (GSG) operating as DSCI’s “Information Technology Division.” Terms of the deal are undisclosed.

Viatech’s capabilities include hardware and software systems solutions, telecommunications, and Information Technology (IT) services and products. Business units include Network Engineering & Integration Services, Information Technology, Systems Engineering, Software Engineering, Software Training, and Management Services.

I fully expect that the synergies of these two IDIQ contract vehicles, a Firm Fixed Price (FFP) vehicle and a Time and Materials (T&M) vehicle will result in superior products and services at substantial cost savings for a broad range of our world-wide C4ISR Customers."
